

Code of Conduct

This code applies to all Victorian Motorcycle Council Inc members, their proxies and elected or nominated members of committees or groups formed to assist the Victorian Motorcycle Council Inc achieve its' objects

1. Respect

- 1.1. All members will treat other members, or persons not members of the VMC, with respect and good manners at all times;
- 1.2. Members will not use physical or verbal abuse towards other members or persons not members of the VMC;
- 1.3. When representing the VMC in other forums, meetings or public gathering, points 1.1 and 1.2 apply.

2. Integrity

- 2.1. Members will not engage in fraudulent or corrupt behaviour;
- 2.2. Contribute to discussions in forums, meetings and public gatherings in an appropriate manner;
- 2.3. Manage conflicts of interest;
- 2.4. Members will not misuse official information for personal or commercial gain for yourself or others;
- 2.5. Maintain the confidentiality and privacy of all information as it pertains to individuals.

3. Commitment

- 3.1. As a member of the Victorian Motorcycle Council Inc you agree, at all times, to comply with the Constitution, By-Laws and Code of Conduct of the VMC identified as the Victorian Motorcycle Council Inc;
- 3.2. Strive at all times to fulfill our Objects as Victorian Motorcycle Council Inc members and Executive Committee members.

4. Accountability and Transparency

- 4.1. Ensure the VMC complies with its' legal and financial obligations;
- 4.2. Ensure appropriate use of the VMC's resources, property and facilities;
- 4.3. Ensure appropriate disclosure and use of VMC information;
- 4.4. Ensure transparency in our dealings with members of the VMC, government members and instrumentalities and the public;
